How to choose the right regulator for your large-capacity jobs

At first, the proper sizing and selection of propane gas regulators for large-capacity loads can seem complicated. But all it really takes is a little knowledge to make the best choice for any situation.

Commonly referred to as commercial or industrial regulators, they're basically just "big" regulators! They do the same job as the more common-sized domestic regulators and require all the same information when making a selection, including inlet and outlet pressure, pipe body size, BTU capacity, and the type of application.

Most people are fairly familiar with self- or direct-operated regulators. Pilot-operated regulators, however, are more nuanced, and it's important to consider the differences between direct- and pilot-operated regulators when deciding what to use in any given situation.

Speed of response and accuracy will guide your decision most of the time. While direct-operated regulators are fast and simple, your range of control is limited. Most pilot-operated regulators require downstream control lines but offer high accuracy.

A system that requires speedy response will most likely require a direct-operated regulator. On the other hand, a system that has a narrow tolerance for pressure fluctuation, such as a boiler system with high-tech controls and safeties, will probably require a pilot-operated regulator.

Factors to Consider When Selecting a Propane Gas Regulator

PILOT-OPERATED

PROS

- High accuracy
- Larger flow capacity
- Stable lockup pressures

CONS

- Slower response
- Complex plumbing
- Higher cost

DIRECT-OPERATED

PROS

- Simplicity
- Quick response

CONS

- · Limited range of control
- Higher lockup pressure
- 10 to 20% loss of pressure at the appliance
