This creates efficiency and reduces the number of deliveries, improving the productivity of your trucks and drivers.

There are other benefits from improved delivery efficiency. Fewer deliveries results in savings from reduced vehicle mileage and maintenance. Avoiding stops at tanks that are close to full allows trucks to deliver more gallons per day. It can also reduce overtime, as a driver's day is not wasted on needless stops. It is possible less temporary labor is needed for winter, as full time employees are better utilized. And a more efficient delivery structure may free up equipment and employee time for other functions, including securing new business.



Tank monitors can increase customer loyalty by preventing "out of gas" situations. A monitor allows you to know the fuel level of your customer's tank from the convenience of your office. Deliveries can then be scheduled accordingly. You become the provider that can make sure there are
